

Articles of Incorporation
Of
Atlanta Georgia Table Tennis Association, Inc.

Article 1.

The name of the corporation is Atlanta Georgia Table Tennis Association, Inc. (aka AGTTA)

Article 2.

The corporation is organized pursuant to Georgia Nonprofit Corporation Code

Article 3.

The street address of the registered office is 3551 Cedar Corners Place, Norcross, Georgia 30092. The registered agent as such address is Mr. Larry Giles. The county of the registered office is Gwinnett.

Article 4.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Further, the corporation exists for the purpose of fostering national and international amateur sports competition through encouragement, promotion, and maintenance of the sport of table tennis as a wholesome form of physical recreation and competition. AGTTA shall actively seek to develop participation in the sport of table tennis by persons of every age, sex, race, color, and creed and by persons with physical and/or mental disabilities and shall seek to associate itself with those local, regional, and/or national organizations or entities which may provide opportunities for such development.

Article 5.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 4 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporations shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a

corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 6.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government , for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article 7.

The corporation will have members comprised of members of the public that wish to support the purposes of the club through their memberships and other contributions.

Article 8.
